Lawyer honored

The Massachusetts Bar Association will honor Amherst resident and Worcester attorney Patti A. Prunhuber with the Legal Services Award at the Access to Justice Awards Luncheon on March 12. The event will be a part of MBA's Annual Conference 2010 held at the Westin Copley Place in Boston.

Prunhuber, an attorney with Legal Assistance Corporation of Central Mass. in Worcester, is one of five attorneys and one law firm to be acknowledged at the luncheon for exemplary pro bono efforts. The Legal Services Award is given to an attorney who has made a particularly significant or meaningful contribution to the provision of low-income legal services, above and beyond the requirements or his or her position.

For 25 years, Prunhuber has worked to ensure that low-income families, immigrants and low-wage workers have access to unemployment compensation, health care, affordable housing and public benefits. She started working at Western Mass. Legal Services in 1985 and moved to LACCM in 2008.
