CHIEF JUSTICE JOHN D. CASEY was appointed as the chief justice of the Probate and Family Court Department on July 16, 2018. Previously, he was an associate justice and then first justice of the Norfolk Probate and Family Court, and was also an associate justice of the Essex Probate and Family Court.

He served as a member of the Commission on Judicial Conduct and the 2025 Transition Leadership Committee, mentored new judges, and served as a panelist at numerous events for the Massachusetts Bar Association, Boston Bar Association, Massachusetts Continuing Legal Education and local bar associations.

For 23 years, he was a partner in the Attleboro law firm of Casey and Thompson PC, where he specialized in family law and criminal defense. He received his undergraduate degree from Bates College and his J.D. from Suffolk University Law School in 1982.
